

Congratulations on the purchase of your Pacbrake exhaust brake!

Installing the exhaust brake into the exhaust system is shown in detail in the Pacbrake installation manual and usually doesn't create many obstacles. However, the electrical interface of the exhaust brake circuit with the pre-existing circuits does create questions and delays in completing the installation. This is solely because every chassis manufacturer has a different way of wiring their chassis and different locations for mounting the components. In the past Pacbrake has provided generic wiring schematics for every combination of engine, transmission and ABS system used in vehicles today and for some installers this works fine.

For those customers who have never installed an exhaust brake or those that have had difficulty with the electrical interface, please find a list of OEM's and their respective technical service hotlines. Before scheduling the vehicle in for the exhaust brake installation, call the vehicle manufacturers hotline with the chassis VIN# and request an exhaust brake wiring schematic. Attaining the manufacturers version of the exhaust brake wiring schematic prior to starting the installation will give your technician a head start.
